Representing the views of players, parents and taking responsibility for communication between the age group and the wider club. The Team Manager, provides advice and guidance to parents and should promotes their age groups interests in the development and direction of the club.

Above all the Team Manager is responsible for passing on communications related to training and matches, coordinating age group volunteers, working with other club volunteers to ensure that the children benefit from playing rugby and that needs and requirements of the individual age group are represented.

- Confident and good at communicating
- Committed to supporting all the children within the age group
- Familiar with the club and key individuals within M&J

What you'll do:

- Manage Teamer and advise parents of training and fixtures
- Lead, advise and support fellow parents
- Make players aware of administrative arrangements
- Check pre-match arrangements have been made
- Coordinate age group volunteers as required
- Help the coach organise training and player development
- Encourage players and other club members to get involved with voluntary work and social activities at the club
- Welcome new members, visiting teams and referees
